Dear Parents / Guardians,

Special Arrangements regarding the Deferral of Class Suspension and Practice of E-Learning

Due to the Novel Coronavirus epidemic, the Education Bureau announced on 25th February that, class suspension of all schools will be extended to the end of schools' Easter holidays, that is, Classes will be resumed from 20th April, the earliest. Therefore, we would like to implement the following administrative arrangements for our students.

(1) E-Learning:

In order to make sure that our students will not stop their learning at home during class suspension, our teachers will keep performing E-Learning for our students through eClass system. However, since the class resumption is further postponed, means of "Online Teaching" (use of different apps, electronic platforms) will be enhanced and followed up with e-learning materials and assignments. Class Teachers and Subject Teachers will contact parents and students through phone and other platforms to understand students' needs and learning progress and offer them assistance if needed. Parents are strongly recommended to motivate their child to participate more to achieve "Suspending classes without suspending learning".

(2) HKDSE 2020:

The HKDSE will be conducted from 27th March 2020, and we will inform our S.6 students later to return to school to pick up the "Admission Form" and the appropriate number of masks for attending their exams at the designated examination sites according to the schedule of their registered subjects.

(3) Subject Weightings of 2nd Semester:

The school will cancel the 2nd Term Test and delay the date of 2nd Term Exam to compensate for the lost periods during the suspension. Thus, the proportion of scores of each subject in the 2nd Term will be changed. The GP marks of 2nd Term will be 20% and the examination marks of 2nd term will be 30% for this academic year.


(4) Summer School Uniforms:

If the Education Bureau announces that classes will resume on 20th April, students will then be required to wear their summer uniforms when back to school.
